(Lothian Road, Fleming Drive, Stewarton)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2024

On 09 July 2024 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (East Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – Lothian Road, Fleming Drive, Stewarton

Phase 1 - Lothian Road - From a point 65m west of its junction with Crusader Crescent eastwards for a length of 490m

Phase 2 - Fleming Drive - 120m northwards from its junction with David Dale Avenue to its junction with Lothian Road

No Waiting At Any Time - Lothian Road, Fleming Drive, Stewarton

Phase 1 - Lothian Road - From a point 65m west of its junction with Crusader Crescent eastwards for a length of 490m both sides of road.

Phase 2 - Fleming Drive - 120m northwards from its junction with David Dale Avenue to its junction with Lothian Road both sides of road.

The Order commences on 27 July 2024 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 27 July 2024 at 08:00 until 25 August 2024 at 18:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 18:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained whenever possible.

An alternative route will be signed via David Dale Avenue, Crusader Crescent and Vice Versa
