



South Ayrshire Council
(C39 Corton, Doonholm Road, Ayr - Alloway)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

On 07 November 2024 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, to allow road safety improvements on A77 trunk road

Temporary Road Closure – C39 Corton, Doonholm Road, Ayr - Alloway,

Doonholm Road - For 160m from junction A77 to Corton Lea Junction

C39 Corton - For 580m from junction A77 to Access The Coo Shed

The Order commences on 25 November 2024 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 25 November 2024 at 06:00 until 28 February 2025 at 20:00.

Junction closures will be temporarily removed during the nearby resurfacing works programmed for weekend of 29th November and weekend of 6th December. Junction closures will also be removed during the Christmas break from 20th December until 8th January.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected

Access for residents and deliveries out-with the working zone will be maintained via diversion route

Diversion Routes will be signed as below

A77 northbound to Doonholm Road Diversion via A79 Maybole Road, Ewenfield Road, B7024.

Doonholm Road to A77 northbound Diversion via B7024, Ewenfield Road, Belmont Road, A713

Dalmellington Road, Bankfield Roundabout

A77 southbound to Doonholm Road via Bankfield Roundabout, A713 Dalmellington Road, Belmont Road, Ewenfield Road, B7024 and vice versa.

A77 to C39 (Corton) Diversion via Bankfield Roundabout, A713 and vice versa.
