

East Ayrshire Council (C127, Galston) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2024

On 10 December 2024 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, to allow Installation of an asset multiplate pipe arch to re-line the structure and associated works

Temporary Road Closure – C127, Galston, 70m at Low Ashyard Bridge

The Order commences on 06 January 2025 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 06 January 2025 at 08:00 with the closure remaining in place until 19 April 2025 at 17:00.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Access for Emergency Services, residents and deliveries out-with the working zone will be maintained via diversion route

Measures will be in place for members of the public using The Sir Chris Hoy Cycle Way to to pass the works safely.

An alternative route will be signed via A71, Turn right on Galston Roundabout onto A719 and follow A719 to junction C127 and vice versa
