On 09 April 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Pavilion Festival Music Event

**Road Closure –**

Pavilion Road - Access route for authorised personnel and vehicles only  
 Place De Saint Germaine En Laye  
 Wellington Square - South  
 Wellington Square - West

**No Waiting At Any Time –**

Alloway Park - Full Length on Both Sides with access for residents parking  
 Bath Place - Full Length on both sides  
 Esplanade from Junction of Pavilion Road Southwards for 250mtrs  
 Fairfield Road - Full Length on both sides with access for residents parking  
 Park Terrace - Full Length on both sides with access for resident parking  
 Place de Saint Germaine en Laye - Full Length on both sides  
 Pavilion Road - Full length on both sides  
 Wellington Square South - Full Length on both sides  
 Wellington Square West - Full Length on both sides  
 Wellington Square North - Full Length on Both Sides with drop off area for buses only

**One Way Operation**

Fort Street to Cassillis Street - Westbound
