### THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (HARBOUR ROAD (PART), INVERNESS) (TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) NOTICE 2026

No. IN260012

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other powers enabling them on that behalf being satisfied that traffic on the length of road referred to in the Schedule ("the Schedule") annexed to this Notice should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road hereby make this Notice.

#### **1. Citation, commencement and cessation**

This Notice may be cited as 'The Highland Council (Harbour Road (Part) Inverness) (Temporary Road Closure) Notice 2026 and shall be in operation from 18 June 2026 at 22:00 until 19 June 2026 at 06:00.

#### **2. Interpretation**

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Notice as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

#### **3. Relationship to existing Orders**

All provisions contained in any Order Enactment or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Notice and the true intent or meaning hereof shall cease to have effect, during the period stated hereto.

#### **4. Reason**

The reason for making this Notice is to enable safe access to railway level crossing during essential inspection and maintenance works.

#### **5. Alternative routes**

Consideration has been given to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Notice. An alternative route for vehicles is available using the B865 Millburn Road - Academy Street - Chapel Street, the M9/A9 Edinburgh - Stirling - Thurso Trunk Road, and the U4023 Harbour Road (Part), Inverness.

#### **6. Temporary prohibition on use of a road**

Save as provided for in Article 7 of this Notice, while this Notice is in force, no person shall drive, or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying by means of one or more of the traffic signs of a type generally provided for under Section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

## **7. Exemptions**

Nothing in Article 6 of this Notice applies to the below, providing always that they comply with such instructions as may be issued to them by the contractor for the works:

- (a) Vehicles employed to carry out the works in respect of which this Order is made, including those employed to carry out associated traffic management.
- (b) Vehicles requiring access to or from premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
- (c) Pedestrians requiring access to or from premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
