(Maxwood Road,Barrmill Road,Blair Crescent,Blair Street, Galston)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2026

On 12 May 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (East Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – Maxwood Road,Barrmill Road,Blair Crescent, Galston

Maxwood Road - Various Sections over full length 640m.

Barrmill Road - For 10m from junction with Maxwood Road

Blair Crescent - For 20m from junction with Maxwood Road

No Waiting At Any Time - Maxwood Road,Barrmill Road,Blair Crescent,Blair Street,Galston

Maxwood Road - Various Sections over full length 640m both sides of carriageway

Barrmill Road - For 10m from junction with Maxwood Road both sides of carriageway

Blair Crescent - For 20m from junction with Maxwood Road both sides of carriageway

Blair Street - For 42m from junction with Henrietta Street both sides of carriageway

The Order commences on 26 May 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 26 May 2026 at 08:00 until 12 June 2026 at 17:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained whenever possible and safe to do so

An alternative route will be signed via U48 Maxwood (Rural), Clockston Road (U1), Cessnock Road (B7037), Station Road (B7037), Duke Street, Blair Street and vice versa
