



**East Ayrshire Council
(C127 Ashyard / Hoodston Bridge, Hurlford)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2026**

On 26 May 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (East Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – C127 Ashyard / Hoodston Bridge, Hurlford

C127, Ashyard / Hoodston Bridge - For 920m Between A71 and Low Ashyard Farm

No Waiting At Any Time - C127 Ashyard / Hoodston Bridge, Hurlford

C127, Ashyard / Hoodston Bridge - For 920m Between A71 and Low Ashyard Farm both sides of carriageway

The Order commences on 08 June 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 08 June 2026 at 08:00 until 15 June 2026 at 18:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 18:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Access for Emergency Services, residents and deliveries out-with the working zone will be maintained via diversion route

An alternative route will be signed via C127, A719, A71 & vice versa
