



**East Ayrshire Council
(Barrmill Road, Galston)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2026**

On 23 June 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (East Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Scottish Power Works

Road Closure – Barrmill Road, Galston

Barrmill Road - From outside no.27 Barrmill Road to junction with Maxwood Road (44m)

No Waiting At Any Time – Barrmill Road, Galston

Barrmill Road - From outside no.27 Barrmill Road to junction with Maxwood Road (44m) both sides of carriageway

The Order commences on 08 July 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 08 July 2026 at 08:00 until 21 July 2026 at 15:00.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order restrictions will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Access for Emergency Services, residents and deliveries out-with the working zone will be maintained via diversion route

An alternative route is Maxwood Road, Henrietta Street, Polwarth Street, Barrmill Road and vice versa
