(C1144 Kingie to junction of A87 Trunk, Invergarry)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2026

On 26th May 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order, to allow RJ MacLeod to conduct PRI Works on the road.

Temporary Road Closure – C1144 Kingie to junction of A87 Trunk, Invergarry, 15km from junction of A87 Trunk.

The works are expected to commence from 01 June 2026 at 08:30 with the closure remaining in place until 19 June 2026 at 16:00.

Works to be completed in sections as outlined below with start and completion dates that are subject to weather conditions permitting and any unforeseen circumstances:

Section 1 - Kingie to Tomdoun (A-B) 01/06/26 to 05/06/26

C1144 Daingean Bridge - Tomdoun - Loch Quoich Road, commencing from 15km or thereby West of junction with A87 and continuing for 6km East before terminating

Section 2 - Tomdoun to Tornacarry Entrance (B-C) 08/06/26 to 12/06/26

C1144 Daingean Bridge - Tomdoun - Loch Quoich Road, commencing from 9km or thereby West of junction with A87 and continuing for 4km East before terminating

Section 3 - Tornacarry Entrance to A87 Junction (C-D) 15/06/26 to 19/06/26

C1144 Daingean Bridge - Tomdoun - Loch Quoich Road, commencing from 4km or thereby West of junction with A87 and continuing for 4km East before terminating at A87 junction

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained.

No alternative route for vehicles is available, closed will be between 08:30hours to 16:00hours Monday to Thursday and 08:30 to 13:00hours on Friday. Outside of those hours the road will remain open.
