



**East Ayrshire Council
(Stevenson Street, Kilmarnock
(Temporary Road Closure, Prohibition of Waiting & Suspension of One Way Operation)
Order 2026**

On 16 June 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (East Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow installation of pedestrian buildout and widening of footways.

Temporary Road Closure – Stevenson Street, Kilmarnock:

For 271m from junction of Bonnyton Road to junction with Irvine Road.

No Waiting At Any Time - Stevenson Street, Kilmarnock:

For 65m from junction of Bonnyton Road to junction with Munro Lane on both sides of carriageway

For 51m from junction with Gibson Street to junction with Stevenson Lane on both sides of carriageway

Suspension of One Way Operation - Stevenson Street, Kilmarnock

For 271m from junction of Bonnyton Road to junction with Irvine Road.

The Order commences on 29 June 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 29 June 2026 at 08:00 until 10 July 2026 at 16:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 16:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained whenever possible and safe to do so.

An alternative route will be signed via Bonnyton Road, Munro Avenue, Irvine Road and vice versa in both directions.
