



**East Ayrshire Council
(B769, Stewarton)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2026**

On 14 July 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – B769, Stewarton,

1.6Km from B769 junction with A735 Stewarton through to North Ayrshire Boundary.

The Order commences on 27 July 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 27 July 2026 at 08:00 until 09 August 2026 at 18:00

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained when possible and safe to do so

An alternative route will be signed via

A735, Kilmaurs, Irvine Road, Cunninghamhead, B769 and vice versa.

Additional Diversion for High sided Vehicles via B778, Fenwick, Main Road, B7038, Glasgow Road, Western Road, Munro Avenue, Irvine Road, Crosshouse, B7081, Springside, Dreghorn, Long Drive, B769 and vice versa
