



**South Ayrshire Council
(B7024, Culroy)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2026**

On 16 July 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – B7024, Culroy

B7024 - For 700m from 20m South of junction to Knockdon C122 Garryholm to 100m North of Culroy House

The Order commences on 03 August 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 03 August 2026 at 08:00 until 17 August 2026 at 17:00.

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained when possible and safe to so

An alternative route will be signed via B7024, High Maybole Road, Alloway, Murdoch's Lone, Doonholm Road, A77, A77 Maybole Bypass, Culzean Road, Barns Terrace, Alloway Road, B7024 and vice versa
