



South Ayrshire Council
(B734 , Barr)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2026

On 09 July 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – B734 , Barr - 1.5km south of Barr to Doularg Farm.

No Waiting At Any Time - B734 , Barr - 1.5km south of Barr to Doularg Farm

The Order commences on 27 July 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 27 July 2026 at 08:00 until 07 August 2026 at 17:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained whenever possible and safe to do so

An alternative route will be signed via B734, A714, A77 Glendoune Street, A77 Henrietta Street, A77 Knockcushan Street, A77 Bridge Street, A77 Old Street, A77 Vicarton Street, B734, Hawkhill Road, B734 and vice versa.
