



**South Ayrshire Council
(B751 , Symington)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting)
Order 2026**

On 16 July 2026 the Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, made the above-named Order to allow Carriageway Resurfacing

Temporary Road Closure – B751, Symington

For 615m from Foxfield Farm, northbound

No Waiting At Any Time - B751, Symington

For 615m from Foxfield Farm, northbound both sides of carriageway

The Order commences on 10 August 2026 and has a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier. The works are expected to commence from 10 August 2026 at 08:00 until 24 August 2026 at 17:00

The road is expected to be closed between 08:00 and 17:00 each day with it being open out-with these times.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Order will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will not be affected and access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained whenever possible and safe to do so

An alternative route will be signed via B751, A759, Drybridge Road, Main Street, Tarbolton Road, B730, B751 and vice versa.
