



**South Ayrshire Council
(Bath Place and Queens Terrace, Ayr - Town Centre)
(Temporary Road Closure)
Emergency Notice 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 14(2)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, that the following Traffic Management restrictions be introduced with immediate effect for emergency gas repair works.

Road Closure –

Bath Place - closed from Esplanade & Place De Saint-Germain-En-Laye.

Queens Terrace closed from its junction with Queens Terrace to its junction with Charlotte Street.

Period of restriction – The Notice is valid for a period of up to 21 days from the date below unless a further notice is issued under Section 15(8)(b)(ii) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The restrictions will only be in force at times when the appropriate signs are displayed. Access to properties and premises will be maintained whenever possible and emergency services and pedestrian access will not be affected.

Alternative routes – will be signed via

Bath Place Westbound - Place De Saint-Germain-En-Laye > Pavillion Road > Esplanade.

Bath Place Eastbound 1 - Esplanade > Charlotte St > Cassillis St > Bath Place.

Bath Place Eastbound 2 - Esplanade > Pavillion Road > Wellington Sq > Bath Place.

Queens Terrace 1 - Charlotte St > Esplanade.

Queens Terrace 2 - Charlotte St > Cassillis St > Bath Place.
