

**South Ayrshire Council
(Esplanade & Pavillion Road, Ayr - Town Centre)
(Temporary Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting) Notice 2026**

NOTICE is hereby given under Section 14(2)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 as amended, and of all other enabling powers, which will introduce the following restrictions to allow De-rig of event equipment.

Name & affected length of road - Esplanade & Pavillion Road, Ayr

Road Closure -

Esplanade, Ayr - Town Centre - Road Closed - From the junction of Blackburn Drive (North Entrance to Blackburn Car Park) to the junction of Pavilion Road.

No Waiting -

Esplanade, Ayr - Town Centre - No Waiting Restriction - From the junction of Blackburn Drive (North Entrance to Blackburn Car Park) to the junction of Pavilion Road (Both sides of carriageway)

Pavilion Road, Ayr - Town Centre - No Waiting Restriction - From junction of Place De Saint - Germain-En-Lay eastwards for 50 meters (Both sides of carriageway)

Nature and period of restriction - Road Closure & Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time

This Notice commences on 06 September 2026 and has a maximum duration of 5 days or until the works are completed, whichever is sooner. The works are expected to commence from 06 September 2026 at 00:01 with the restrictions remaining until 08 September 2026 at 23:59.

The days and times of the works may be dependent upon the weather conditions but the Notice will be implemented only when the appropriate signs are displayed.

Emergency Services access will be affected and access will be maintained via diversion route only.

Access for residents, deliveries and pedestrians' out-with the working zone will be maintained via diversion route only.

Pavilion Road - Wellington Square - Alloway Place - Racecourse Road - Seafield Road - Blackburn Drive and vice versa
